Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to ensure that the Board staff will have adequate time to fully review all timely submitted applications prior to the next regularly scheduled Board meeting, furthering the goal of the Board and ensuring that the Board meets its fiduciary duty in administering the fund.

Authority: K.S.A. 2-3710

Policy: In order for the Board to sufficiently review each application for reimbursement of costs from the remediation reimbursement fund, it shall be the established policy of the Board that in order for any application to qualify to be reviewed by the Board, based upon its assigned priority score, said application must have been submitted to the KARB offices no later than four (4) weeks prior to the date of the next regularly scheduled Board meeting.

Title: *Maximum Reimbursement amount: \$200,000.00 per defined site*

Purpose: As of the date of the adoption of this policy (14-02), the Kansas agricultural remediation fund was underfunded by approximately \$2 million. The purpose of this policy is to ensure that, with the limited funds available, and pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas legislature, the Board is able to carry out the stated purpose of the remediation reimbursement program by providing reimbursement to eligible persons for the costs of remediation activities approved by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) or taken in accordance with requests or orders issued by the KDHE, and approved by the Board.

Authority: K.S.A. 2-3708(b).

Policy: In order for the Board to satisfy the purpose of the remediation reimbursement program and remediation reimbursement fund of reimbursing eligible parties for agricultural remediation expenses, it shall be the established policy of the Board that the total amount of reimbursement from the fund for a release identified by the KDHE shall not exceed \$200,000 at any one site, except that if the property has been sold or leased and both the buyer and seller (or lessee and lessor) are responsible for the remediation costs at that site, then the total amount reimbursed shall not exceed \$400,000 for that site.
